# What are the program specifics?

- ♦ 5 year apprenticeship program
  - \* Minimum of 960 Hours Classroom Instruction and 8000 OJT
  - \* Class in the evenings 1-2 nights per week with summers off
- Earn a living wage while developing a career path
- Receive college credit at no cost to you

# How can I apply?

You will need to apply in person at the Washington County - Ohio Means Jobs. They will assist you with the application packet, and proctor the aptitude test.

### You Will Need:

- Official transcripts in a sealed envelope, faxed, or emailed directly to mejatc@ibew972.org
  - \*Must be a high school graduate or equivalent (or a senior on the path to graduate)
  - \*You must have passed one year of high school algebra.
- Valid Drivers License—Minimum of 17 years old (18 when indentured)
- DD-214 (if you have a military background)
- Optional / Encouraged:

Resume, Letters of Recommendation, Awards, Certificates, Diploma, Social Security Card, etc.

After completing the process at Ohio Means Jobs, you will contact the Training Center to schedule a time to complete the application process and pay a \$20 processing fee.
