

Beallsville High School Parent Involvement Plan

I. Goals

- A. Parents will be informed about all aspects of the Title I Program through on campus school meetings. Title I and other Intervention Staff meet with parents at the building's annual "open houses" and parent-teacher conferences where discussions of curriculum, means of assessment and the proficiency levels students are expected to achieve and maintain can be discussed.
- B. Suggestions for parents on ways they can help their children to be successful academically will be offered during conferences as well as explanations of program requirements.
- C. Staff involved in the program will have professional development opportunities designed to train them to work effectively with parents.
- D. Ways to involve parents in the design, operation, and evaluation of the program may include, (but not be restricted to) surveys, home/school communications, meetings, workshops, and progress reports. These ongoing means will enable parents and school to work together so that parents may gain a feeling of partnership in their children's education.
- E. Parents lacking literacy skills or whose native language is not English will have Title I information relayed to them in a format that will be communicative to them.
- F. Timely response to parent recommendations will be made.
- G. An annual assessment of parent involvement effectiveness will be conducted.

II. Mechanisms

- A. Title I Parent Involvement Policy will be made available to all parents.
- B. Progress reports will be issued each year. Conferences will be scheduled with classroom teachers, and may include Title I Teachers to discuss the child's progress, placement, and methods to help the child's instruction.
- C. Parents are informed of all assessment data regarding standardized tests, Ohio Graduation Tests and Ohio Achievement Assessments.
